

Software Use Agreement

between the Emerson Center and its Subscriber

1. Subscriber of the Cherry L. Emerson Center for Scientific Computation of Emory University (hereinafter referred to as Emerson Center) and users authorized under his/her Emerson Center account are entitled to use all software licensed to the Emerson Center on the computers operated by the Emerson Center and, in the case a site license is obtained, on the computers operated by his/her own group within Emory University.
2. The use of software shall be restricted to purposes of non-commercial academic research and education.
3. Any software and documentations are subject to copyright. Therefore, Subscriber should ensure that the software and documentations are protected against unauthorized copying and/or transferring to computers other than those authorized in Article 1.
4. In the publication of the results obtained by the use of Emerson Center, Subscriber and users authorized under his/her Emerson Center account shall acknowledge the use of the Emerson Center facilities and the specific software.
 - i. The used Software should be acknowledged by giving an appropriate citation that should include the name of the software, authorship, the source and appropriate copyright notice.
 - ii. The use of the Emerson Center facilities should be acknowledged by adding the following sentence at the end of the publication. "Acknowledgment is made to the Cherry L. Emerson Center of Emory University for the use of its resources, which are in part supported by a National Science Foundation grant (CHE-0079627) and an IBM Shared University Research Award."
